# NTOS OUR DOWN UNDER



The Santos Tour Down Under is looking for South Australian junior cyclists to join us as a Stage Assistant and help us with the official race starts and winner presentations of the 2020 Santos Tour Down Under & Santos Women's Tour Down Under.

## **DUTIES**

On each day stage assistants will undertake the following duties:

#### **Race Starts:**

At the race starts the Stage Assistants are there to ensure that all riders sign on correctly, aid the commentators during interviews and help see the riders off for each stage.

## **Winner Presentations:**

The Stage Assistants are the front of house people who direct and manage the presentations on the stage, the entry and exit to the stage of riders and presenters and ensuring the presenters and riders have the correct trophies and gifts and move into position for official photos.

#### **Team Presentation:**

Assisting with the entry and exit of all men's and women's teams.

#### UNIFORM

As a Stage Assistant, you will be provided with an official uniform consisting of polo, shorts and shoes. It is expected that you will keep these items clean and pressed at all times.

#### **REHEARSALS**

As part of the requirements for taking on a stage assistant role you are required to be available for three rehearsals, which will be held at the Hilton Adelaide Hotel. The times indicated below are not set and may change, but all rehearsals will take place during the school holidays

- Monday 16th December 3:30pm 5:00pm
- Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 3:00pm 4:30pm
- Monday 13th January 3:00pm 4:30pm

## WHO CAN BE A STAGE ASSISTANT?

All stage assistants must be young riders aged between 13 – 17 on the first day of the event, being the 16 January 2020.

Stage assistants must be members of a cycling club, or a part of the SASI young rider program.

To apply, young riders must have parental consent and are asked to complete the online form.







# **EVENT DATES & AVAILABILITY**

Stage Assistants will assist across both the women's and men's races performing the same roles. Whilst you don't have to be available for all shifts, you are required to be available for at least 10 shifts across the Santos Tour Down Under in order to be eligible to become a Stage Assistant. ## **HOW TO APPLY**

Applications are through <u>SATC's volunteer portal</u>. Please select "Santos Tour Down Under Stage Assistant".

The application will ask you for all your details, including your uniform sizing and a photo for your credential if successful (if you don't have one handy we can take one if you are successful). It will also ask you to tell us why you would like to be a stage assistant, so please have a think about this before you commence your application. The application should be completed by the young rider and parent/guardian together, as there is a parent/guardian sign off required.

**Applications close Friday 15 November 2019.** All applicants will be notified on the outcome of their application by Friday 6 December 2019.
