

PORT ADELAIDE CYCLING CLUB POLICY JUNIOR GRANTS



Introduction

The Port Adelaide Cycling Club (PACC) is committed to providing financial assistance to its junior members (and parents/caregivers) to assist with costs of competing on behalf of the Club at local, State and National competition. This is done via the programs outlined in this policy.

Junior Scholarships

Eligibility

To be eligible for a Junior Scholarship, you must:

- Be a current PACC member (either Cycling Australia or Mountain Bike Australia affiliation);
- Be U23 level or younger in the year of competition;
- Be selected to a State or National team or have been competing at the national level of competition on a regular basis.

Policy

- The total amount available for Junior Scholarships is at the discretion of the PACC Committee. This funding will be distributed amongst those who successfully obtain a scholarship.
- Scholarships can be used at the discretion of the recipient, and are intended to be used to offset costs incurred for travel, accommodation and purchases of cycling kit or equipment.
- Scholarships are available each calendar year between 1 April and 31 March, and apply for representation during that period.
- Members (or their parent / caregiver) are to apply in writing with details of racing and results during the eligible period.
- Applications must be received via email to committee@pacc.org.au by 5:00pm 31 March each year.
- Applications will be considered at the April meeting of the Committee.
- Recipients will be announced at the Club's Annual General Meeting, generally held in May each year.

Junior Jersey Offer – High School Students

Eligibility

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must:

- Be a current or joining PACC member (either Cycling Australia or Mountain Bike Australia affiliation);
- Be attending high school;
- Be representing the Club in competition on a regular basis.

Policy

- Members who are attending high school are eligible to receive a free jersey at the time of joining or renewing membership with PACC.
- It is expected that the member will wear the club jersey when representing PACC at competitions.
- Members are eligible for one short sleeved club jersey per membership year.
- Members may elect to receive discount on another item of PACC branded racing kit to the value of a short sleeved jersey.
- Members (or their parent / caregiver) are to apply in writing with details of racing and results during the eligible period.
- Applications including name, membership number and renewal date are to be forwarded to committee@pacc.org.au.

Sports Vouchers – Primary School Students

Eligibility

The Sports Vouchers program is a Government of South Australia initiative administered by the Office for Recreation, Sport and racing. The program provides an opportunity for primary school aged children (Reception to Year 7) to receive up to \$100 discount on membership and cycling kit.

All South Australian primary school aged children are eligible to make one claim per calendar year.

Policy

- Sports Vouchers may be used to reimburse members for the cost of their membership (either MTBA or CA affiliation), plus provide one short sleeved jersey per claim.
- Members may elect to receive discount on another item of PACC branded racing apparel to the value of a short sleeved jersey.
- Applications must be received via email to secretary@pacc.org.au and can be done at any time, up until 31 December of the year of the claim.
- This fund will be available for as long as is funded by the Government of South Australia (currently until 2021-22), and will be managed in accordance with the Terms and Conditions available at www.sportsvouchers.sa.gov.au
